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Supplier Agreement

Purpose

The purpose of this agreement is to outline suppliers' acceptance to act in accordance with the guidelines, regulations and standards on sourcing "Conflict–Minerals"; and to provide Chivine Resources, Inc. (CRI) assistance in conducting proper due-diligence to maintain a responsible, conflict-free sourcing supply chain. Conflict-Minerals for the sake of this agreement are **gold**, **ores of tin**, **tantalum**, and **tungsten** sourced from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and/or its adjoining countries.

As a supplier doing business with Chivine Resources, Inc, we understand and agree to adhere to all legislation, policies, practices and rules governing the sourcing of conflict minerals.

We acknowledge and understand that section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act obliges CRI to report whether conflict minerals are necessary to the functionality or production of purchased products originated from DRC or its adjoining countries.

We acknowledge and understand that if materials originated from DRC or any of its' adjoining countries, CRI will initiate due-diligence proceedings to ensure responsible sourcing practices.

We agree to cooperate with CRI (at no cost to CRI) by complying with necessary duediligence investigation on all parts, products and/or materials delivered to CRI.

In order for CRI to remain in compliance with the laws governing conflict minerals we agree to assist CRI in all disclosures and reporting obligations necessary to determine responsible sourcing. Such assistance may include, but shall not to be limited to:

- Assist CRI in determining origin of country of supplied products, parts and/or materials.
- Complete and submit all questionnaires and/or templates relating to origin of minerals
- Assist CRI in obtaining questionnaires and/or templates from direct or indirect vendors

If CRI is unable to determine conflict-free origin of materials, scraps and/or recycled materials, we agree to:

- Provide written documentation at CRI request, certifying efforts taken to indicate conflict-free practices from processing facilities.
- Provide written documentation determining efforts used to ensure that the origin of materials were not directly or indirectly financed or of benefit to "armed groups" (as defined in the conflict mineral law)
- A third-party audit that are in accordance to the U.S Comptroller General.
